for fading. The line can sometimes become weak and brittle. Light fade is ok but when it turns from dark green to white that is not good and time to replace the line.

With Mono and floral-carbine line if it is fraying and changing color it is time for it to be replaced. When you put your rods away for the off season you should back the drag right off. With the change in temps and humidity in your house the pressure on your bearings after time your drag will stop working and wreck your reel. Now if you use your reel a lot you should take it apart and clean it. Put fresh grease and oil on the parts that need to have it put on. So hopefully these will make the winter go a little faster.

anticipation.

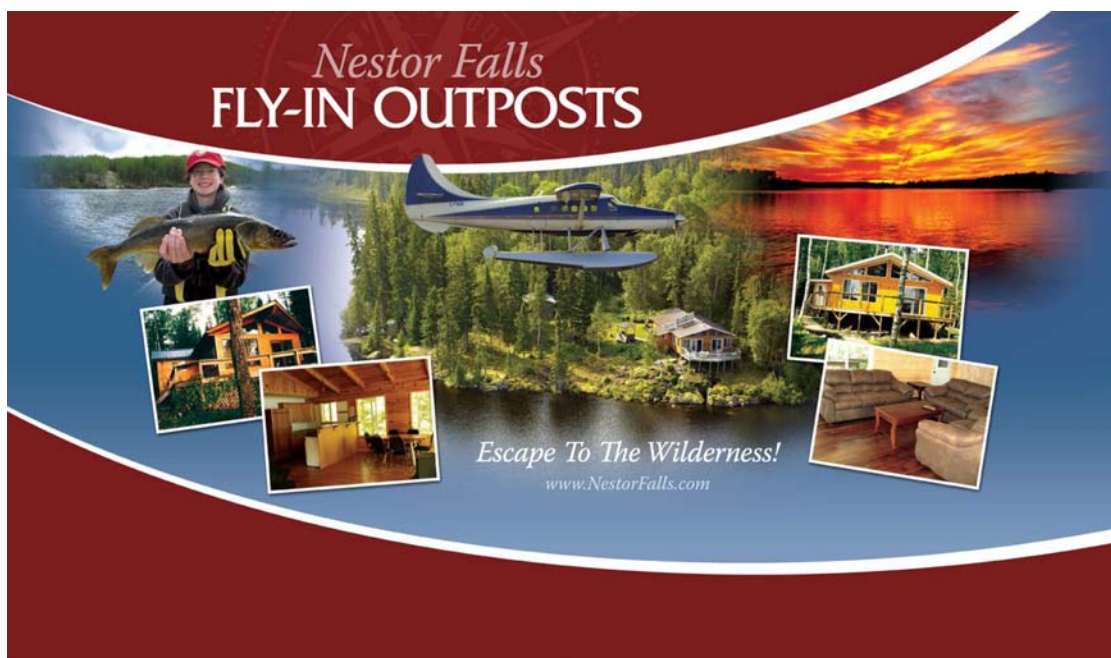
It will be a long winter with such an adventure to look forward to!
