With another season upon us we are gearing up. All the boys arrived back to work on May 1st.

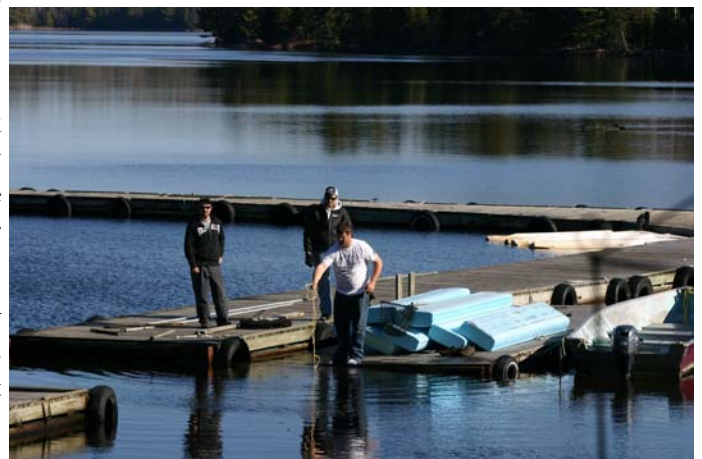
