The last couple of summers have not been the greatest of flying weather with the rain we had been getting. 2011 comes along with record snowfalls and a wet start to the season who would have ever thought we would be fighting fires making flying up north tough at times.

The above picture made headlines all over the country up here. We were on the weather channel, Winnipeg, and Kitchener news paper. We even made it down to the Duluth and Minneapolis area.

The fires started up here mid July and all were lightening strikes. Fire Red 84 took in Malaher, Herod, Malette, Onepine and spread to Cairns Lake. We were shut down briefly at these locations. To date this fire has burnt 31562.6 ha.

If having the fire was not enough. We got water damage at Onepine from the sprinkler system. The guests had left the

windows and sliding doors open while out fishing because it was so hot. The crew that goes around to refuel and start up the sprinklers again never thought to go check on the cabin windows since the fuel tank is down by the dock and the rest is history.

The end of July we had a fire on Clear Lake start on the Island in front of our Outpost cabin. They put a crew of 14 and a couple of planes on this one.

Red 124 fire started August 1. This is the Larus Lake fire and as of August 21, it had burnt 21,557 ha.

We are grateful to all the fire fighters who helped to prevent our Outpost cabins from burning up.

Through all the turmoil the fishing has stayed consistence. We have had several trophies released throughout the summer.
