If you weren't here this spring you missed out on some great fishing. We had lots of really nice Northern's released between 38-44 inches.

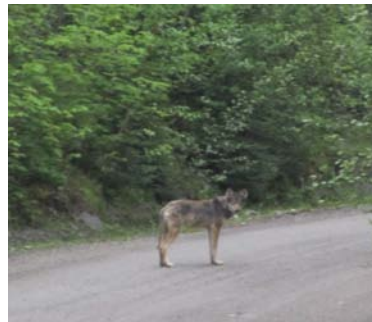
