A must for the outdoor adventurer's list would be Onepine Lake. This location also offers you

excellent Northern fishing. Available June 8-12.

Of course with the spring you never know what it will bring for weather. You may choose to come fishing in the warmer weather. Larus Lake would be another great choice with Availability July 1-5.
