I did take one home. We boiled it in water with a bay leaf and pickling spice. Served it with garlic butter and onions. It was so tasty.

The largest Northern so far for the season was a 43 inch

released at Clear Lake. Onepine has reported some excellent Walleye fishing with the Bojda party released 1100 Walleyes in 5 days with the largest being 26 inches and a 39 inch Northern Pike.

8 year old Sawyer Sullivan at Larus landed a Northern that grabbed onto his Walleye.

8 year old Grant Vineyard landed a 40 inch northern at the dock with a bare hook.

Dan Shattuck's group at Lount Lake has reported seeing a big Timber Wolf, Moose and Black Bear to go along with the Walleye, Northern and Bass they caught.
