Here are some tackle manufactures videos of baits that Jon did very well with last summer that we would like to share with you. These videos show you things about the Baits that people might not know.

The first manufacture is Tightlines UV. Jon uses the grubs for Walleyes. For the Pike he likes using the bait called the Big Fat Jerk. For smallmouth he uses the UV Tube, UV-beaver, and the Skinny-little Jerk. Jon has caught some nice fish on these baits. Here is the link to the video it is on youtube

Jon really likes for Smallmouth fishing. It run's true; right out of the box. You don't need to do anything to the bait unlike others on the market. On Kay Lake the natural colors work the best. Here is the link to this video for the Spro-little John series .

The last is an unreal pike bait. Jon has used this for the Pike and Smallmouth Bass fishing for years. He likes all the colors it comes in. It is a twitch bait; by that he means pull your rod tip once-pause-twitch two times- pause and keep repeating. Link to this video
